

Canadian Association of Rural and Remote Nursing Political Action Committee Terms of Reference

Purpose of committee:

- 1. Identify socio-political issues at the local, regional, provincial/territorial, and federal levels that influence rural/remote nursing practice.
- 2. Propose strategies that will positively influence socio-political initiatives which influence nursing practice and more specifically rural/remote nursing practice i.e. develop tool kit
- 3. Liaise with provincial and territorial professional/regulatory nursing organizations and national professional organizations (provincial registration bodies, Canadian Nurses Association, Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing.)
- 4. Liaise with international professional nursing organizations (International Council of Nurses Rural and Remote Network, Rural Nurse Organization.)

Committee members:

- 1. Ideally 4-6 regular members of CARRN in good standing (membership fees are paid) with geographical representation (i.e. West, Prairie, Central, North, East).
- 2. Volunteer positions for a minimum of a 2 year term. Members will change every year so that one half the Committee will remain while new members join to promote Committee and project continuity.
- 3. Chair will be selected by the committee. The chair will be a 2 year appointment with the option of renewal.
- 4. The Committee Chair will report to the CARRN Executive.
